Summary of PSP spending 2016/17

Objectives in spending PSP:

Offer CPD opportunities for teachers and staff when working with sports coaches during afternoon sessions.

Summary of spending and actions taken:

Breakfast sport clubs – gymnastics

After school sports clubs run by SUFC and DE Dance and Sports - hockey, parkour, athletics and football skills.

Improve competition results for Birley with using afterschool clubs to prepare children for various competitions therefore they have more practise for competitions. This should help to improve confidence in children who are participating.
